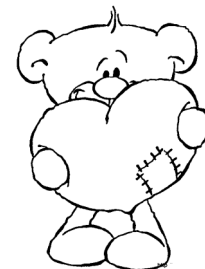

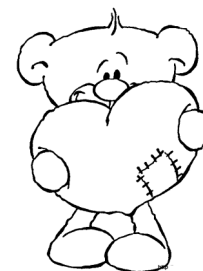
Open House
