Total Expenses for Budgeted Expenses	\$177,224.32

Through the end of June, we have spent \$2,575.08 more than we have received. Even though we have spent more than we have received, we are still much improved than last year. At this point in 2023, we had spent about \$14,000 more than we had taken in. Our income is running about \$9,000 more than at this point last year.
