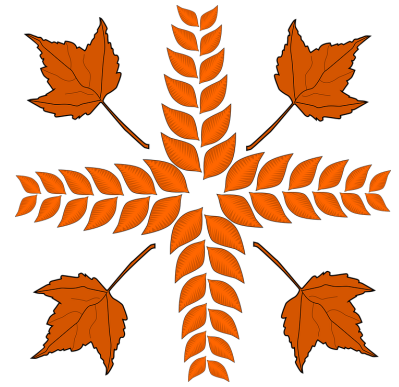

(Tune: I'm a Little Teapot)

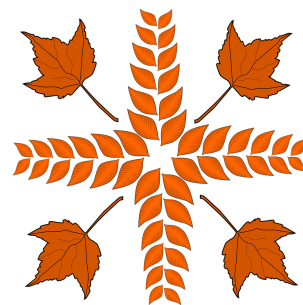
I'm a little scarecrow, stuffed with hay,
