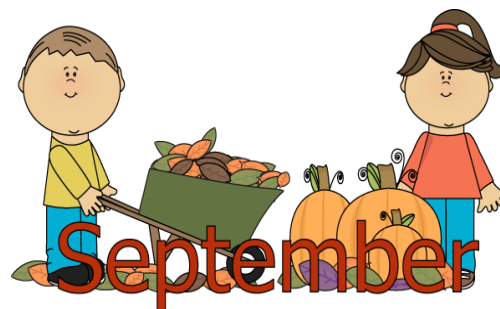


Christian Day Nursery School

Welcome to Pre-K! I have some very exciting things planned for your child this year and I hope together we will help your child love school. This month we will be focusing on colors, shapes and numbers, as well as emotions and being a good friend. I'm sure this is a refresher for many of your students, but often when they master skills at an early age we forget to review. As we are reviewing I will be assessing the children to see where to begin next month. Throughout the year I plan many outdoor and messy science activities, I ask that you dress your child appropriately, in "play clothes" so we can explore rather than worry about a "mess".

Classes begin at 9:00 and 12:30. We will dismiss at 11:30 and 3:00. Please be prompt in dropping off and picking up your child as to not disrupt the routine of the day. Thank you.

Please have your child hang any book bags or outerwear on the coat rack outside of the classroom door before going into the bathroom. Please encourage your child to use the facilities, and at very least, **WASH THEIR HANDS**, before entering the classroom. Make sure I am aware that they have entered the classroom and I have acknowledged their presence before leaving.

Tuition is due the first day of the month or before. Please put your tuition in an envelope marked with the first and last name of your child and place in the container just outside the office door. Tuition must be up to date for your child to attend classes. If you foresee a problem, please ask for a tuition assistance form.

Large Motor is every Monday. Please remember to dress your child in tennis shoes and shorts/pants.

School pictures will be taken by Lifetouch on Sept 25. All packages are prepaid. More information will be forthcoming.

Popcorn fundraiser and orders are due by Friday September 5. Delivery will be on Tuesday September 24. Please help support the school with this local popcorn vendor.

Due to the small size of the Pre-K classes, **snack** will be assigned for the entire week. I have found this is easier than you trying to remember snack every 6 to 10 school days. When it is your child's week his/her name will be listed on the monthly calendar in the snack (Sunday) column. You may bring snack for the entire week on Monday or you may bring it daily, which ever is more convenient for you. Please remember all snacks must be individually packed, but do not have to be store packaged. Snack sized baggies are just the right size to prevent waste. Pre-k has switched to using washable cups so you are not required to bring any cups, napkins are appreciated.

Scholastic book order forms come home monthly with your newsletter. This is an optional program but they have exceptional prices on books. You may order online using classroom code **DWV7Y**, and pay by credit card or you may turn your order into me paying via check made out to Scholastic by the 15th of the month.

I look forward to working with you to make your child's Pre K experience a wonderful one. We are partners in teaching them and helping them grow. Please keep me informed of anything you feel may effect your child's learning experience and feel free to approach me with any ideas or concerns.
